- Help is here. Free preparation assistance for the application, ESL, and the exam is available, regardless of income.
- So you can vote in the next election
- Protection from deportation for yourself (and your children)
- To petition for more family members to join you in the United States before immigration reform limits categories of kinship
- You may qualify for a fee waiver!

### Languages

English, Spanish, French, Arabic, Chaldean, and more

### You will need to bring the following documents to the workshop:

- ✓ Your Permanent Resident Card (“green card”)
- ✓ Two passport photos (2”x2”) of yourself.
- ✓ Your driver’s license or state ID card.
- ✓ Your Social Security number
- ✓ If you are married to a U.S. citizen, his/her birth certificate and/or certificate of naturalization only if married for less than five years
- ✓ All marriage certificates and divorce records
- ✓ Your children’s birth certificates if they are also permanent residents
- ✓ List of residences for the past five years.
- ✓ List of employers/schools for the past five years.
- ✓ List of all trips outside the U.S. for the past five years (including to Canada and Mexico).
- ✓ Tax returns for the past five years, if you file
- ✓ Check or money order for \$680, payable to the Department of Homeland Security, OR you may qualify for a fee waiver. Call to inquire.
